THE MACCABI WORLD EXECUTIVE

Composition: Members of the World Executive, elected by Congress (Mexico 1969) remain in office for a period of 4 years, until next Congress (1973). The Constitution of the Movement, however, allows for changes in membership under certain conditions.

Regarding Executive members residing outside of Israel, some of them are no longer in office today in their respective territorial organizations, but only in one instance (Argentina) was an enquiry made concerning the replacement of one Executive member by another, though no final decision was forwarded.

In the Israel Executive Headquarters, the following changes occurred:

- a) the resignation of Chaver Yehoshua Hadari from his position as Honorary Secretary. Chaver Israel Ben-Nun took over this position, being relieved of his task as Joint-Honorary Treasurer, but remaining as Chairman of the Executive's Finance Committee.
- b) Chaver Eliezer Argov, elected by Congress and responsible in the Executive for "Education", asked to be relieved for health reasons and Chaver Simcha Friedman undertook this office in the Executive.
- c) Chaver Abraham Friedmann relinquished his membership in the World Executive, but remains as a "financial adviser" to the Executive.
- d) Chaver Gideon Pat, member of Knesset, joined the World Executive in Israel as a result of nomination by Maccabi Israel and is in charge of the Executive's Aliyah Department. His adoption to the Executive was made following a Resolution of the plenary meeting of the World Executive in August 1969, giving Maccabi Israel a further seat on the Executive provided that their nominee would be able to deal with Aliyah.
- e) Chaver George Flesch, upon completion of a mission to the U.S.A. on behalf of the State of Israel Bonds, returned to Tel Aviv and was entrusted with "special tasks".

Working Procedure: The Israel Executive members act as the World Executive Headquarters, working as follows:

Executive Meetings: The Executive, under the Chairmanship of the late Chaver Leo Kowarsky, met twice each month and since the plenary meeting in August 1969 regular meetings have taken place. The Executive, apart from dealing with running matters, sees its main task in the implementation of decisions and resolutions taken at the 16th World Congress in Mexico 1968 and following up the plenary session held in August 1969.

The main objects, as laid down, are as follows:-
