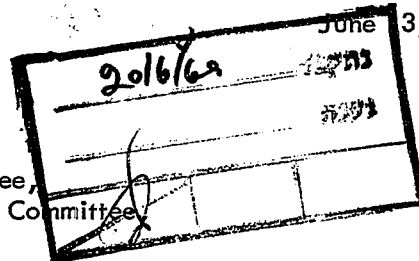

Dear Rivka,

This is further to my letter of today's date.

- Will you be able to get the Canadian team into the Village?
We may number between 25 or 35, depending if we have enough funds for a basketball team - plus 6 golfers who will be staying in Caesera, and probably 2 yachters.
- Part of our team is going to be Miss Myrtle Cook, former Olympic champion 1928 (Amsterdam) Sprint - and now sportswriter for the Montreal Star, the leading evening newspaper in Canada. Miss Cook is a tremendous help to us - not only with her write-ups as per cutting enclosed. We propose to pay for her trip, which is unofficial - meaning her newspaper will not contribute, but want her to write a 5-issue story on sports and physical education in Israel.

She wants to meet Israeli champions, make performance comparisons with other countries in similar conditions, and would like to see institutions such as Wyngate.

The Montreal Star is read by millions of people, therefore we are anxious that she should have facilities at her disposal.

As to her lodgings, we would like her either to stay at the Village, or wherever the girls will be housed, and this at reasonable rates.

- Re: Cameron Grout - He was medal winner at the Olympics in Rome and he is now an international swimming referee; he was chairman of our selection committee, and would like to accompany us to Israel. Whilst he could stay in the Village, would it be possible for you to find accommodations for his wife, not too far from the Village, but not too expensive.

I hope Dr. Atlasz will be able to use him as time keeper or referee, and I am sending copy of this letter to him.

Abby Hoffman leads team listed for Maccabiah event

Joey Richman and members of his Selection Committee have approved twenty-one athletes for Canada's Maccabiah Games team and cited several more nominees for further consideration.

Canada's outstanding distance runner, Abby Hoffman of Toronto was given the green light for the 800 and 400 metres runs. Also named to the track and field team were Arthur Sandman, Max Gould and Joey Levy.

Carl Schwende, representing fencing, recommended Peter Bakonyi, John Erderley and Robert Cardoza. Bakonyi and Erderley were named to the team. Cardoza is on the list for further consideration. Terry Farnsworth of Montreal was the lone judo man nominated and he was named to the team.

Felice Trachman and Barry Naymark were the shooters named following nomination by Frank McCormick and George Wylie.

Committee man Cameron Grout presented the names of swimmers Karen James, Vancouver, Paul Lotman, Toronto and Debbie Shantz, all of whom made the standards, and they were named to the team.

Joyce Hecht will represent Canada in table tennis.

Four weightlifters will carry Canadian colors. The men named last night were Phil Altman, Winnipeg, Len Wolman, Montreal, Victor Zalm, Winnipeg and Harry Goldberg, Toronto. Herb Singerman was named for wrestling. He is a Montrealer.

The Selection Committee also approved the entry of teams for volleyball, basketball and water polo. The members of these teams were not named last night. There was considerable discussion of the polo team because the Canadian champions have on their roster two gentiles. The Maccabiah rules call for participation by Jewish athletes. Syd Kastner made a strong plea to keep

his titleholders intact. His efforts were defeated. The team entrants must raise the funds to field their teams. Vicki Berner, Vancouver and Mike Belkin, Montreal were named for tennis.

Dear Dr. Atlasz,

I hasten to write you today to inform you of our Committee's decision in connection with Canada's participation in the 8th Maccabiah Games.

GOLF. We will have a team of six, possibly three or four of them accompanied by their wives. We have written to the Caesarea Golf & Country Club informing them of this fact and asking them to make the necessary arrangements at either the Caesarea Hotel (Club Mediterranean) or at the Semadar. We would be most grateful if you would follow up on this reservation through your office.

SAILING. We propose to bring a full contingent of sailors. Many of them will bring their wives and in this party we estimate there will be about 14 to 20 people, of which one-third may be tourists.

Accommodation should also be provided for this group, near where the yachting events will take place.

LAWN BOWLING. We are sorry but we will have no lawn bowlers participating in the competitions.

ATHLETES. We hope to have approximately 15 to 23 athletes. Tentative composition would be as follows:

ACCOMMODATION FOR ATHLETES. The wish has been expressed that all the athletes, with the exception of golfers and sailors, should be located at the best available accommodation in the Village. We would want to take advantage of the Village atmosphere whilst participating at the Maccabiah Games.

DATE OF ARRIVAL. We propose to arrive on July 25, leaving August 12.

REFEREES, JUDGES & TIMEKEEPERS. We will have qualified judges, referees and timekeepers available for the following sports:

- ✓ Basketball
- ✓ Wrestling
- ✓ Weightlifting
- ✓ Swimming
- ✓ Track & Field

All of them will be at your disposal, free of any charge to the organizing committee.

NEW WEIGHT CLASS FOR WEIGHTLIFTING & WRESTLING. I would be in favour of having the competition in eight weight classes only and I am practically certain that the International Sports Association in these two sports will not object if you were to make clear to them that the M.I.G.C. does not allow competition in ten weight classes.

WRESTLING. Recognizing the fact that the Israeli referees have not yet been made aware of the latest (simplified) regulations, I am convinced that a clinic held a day prior to the Games would do the trick. I am quite willing to hold such a clinic, if you so desire. On the other hand, however, I am sure that Roger Coulon will accept your invitation and

would be, by far, the best person to hold this clinic. Otherwise, Bert Jacobs would be better qualified than myself. So you really have a good choice in this sport.

In weightlifting, I believe that Oscar State will be only too pleased to get things in running order-

JUNIOR TENNIS. We hope to have one or two juniors with us, below the age of 18 on January 1, 1969.

RE TOUR OF ISRAEL. We are making arrangements for our athletes and tourists to tour the country for at least three days after the close of the Games.

FUND RAISING. Our objective is to raise \$1250 per athlete (a little more for the golfers and sailors) so that we can take care of travel expenses, stay in Israel and uniforms, plus of course a donation to Maccabiah Village as in former years.

We will be starting this fund raising activity within the next two weeks. However, we are encountering great difficulties due to the fact (a) that the Canadian Government recognizes the Canadian Olympic Association as the only sports body registered for tax deductible receipts. (b) We had hoped to make some arrangement with the Canadian Zionist Federation but Mr. Sam Chaite, the President, has informed us that the Jewish agency will not allow tax deductible receipts to be issued for any Maccabiah Games contributions. We may, therefore, have to resort to editing a souvenir programme and contributions to advertising will then be treated as a tax deductible business expense.

Dear Dr. Atlasz,

First of all, let me thank you for the very kind reception you granted me whilst in Israel.

I travelled from Tel Aviv to Munich with Chaver S. Lalkin, Secretary General of the Sports Federation of Israel, and we had 3 hours of pleasant, quiet discussion about Maccabiah, and we concluded there was a certain lack of organisation on some points.

There is no question in my mind that the Maccabiah has become such a tremendously important sports event, that the Sports Federation of Israel ought to play a leading role in its actual organisation. It ought obviously be the job of every sports' chairman to look after his own particular event, and not suddenly have someone from the Maccabiah Organising Committee thrust upon him. In my opinion, it should be the other way around!

One member of the Maccabiah Organising Committee should be co-opted to the individual sport disciplines. For obvious reasons, the Chairman of a Sports Federation should be in Israel, understanding most about each particular sport - hence, my suggestion.

I, for one, just do not believe in belittling the Maccabiah's world reputation by letting the handling of individual sport events in the hands of people who, although very willing, are not fully conversant with up-to-date world sports conditions. I hope I have made my point clear.

Furthermore, I believe that the Wingate pupils ought to be deeply involved in the organising committees because, after all, they are going to be pros in the field of sports.

This letter is not written to criticize the tremendous work done by your committee in Israel, but to help it, as I firmly believe that the Sports Federation and the student body of Wingate ought to be involved in the organisation.

I have just returned from Israel to attend an Executive Meeting of the International Maccabiah Games Committee. To my great surprise, I could not find, either whilst in Israel or since my return (being a regular reader of your newspaper) any information or coverage regarding the biggest and most important sport event in Israel scheduled to take place from July 28 to August 7, 1969.

Literally thousands of officials, fund raisers, professional staff members of Jewish centres, athletes, etc., have - for the past 6 months or so - been organising, scheming, training and preparing to represent their respective countries in Israel, in a way somewhat similar to athletes and organising committees preparing for the British Commonwealth Games, the Pan-American Games, or the Olympic Games!

And you - the only English language newspaper of Israel - do not find it important enough to let your readers all over the world know what is going on!

I have therefore to assume that your publication is completely against these Games; if that is the case, then why don't you state so clearly and openly? The 8th Maccabiah will be held in Israel - with or without your coverage - but Jews all over the world should know why a paper of your reputation and status takes such a defeatist and negative attitude.

Speaking as a Jew, a Canadian who is not only a member of the Metropolitan Board of Directors of YMHA's, but also Chairman of the Canadian Amateur Wrestling Association, Director of the Canadian Olympic Association, Presidential Member of the Fédération Internationale des Luttes Amateur, and last but not least - a reader of your newspaper, I would appreciate your publishing this letter along with your answer, and perhaps a resulting editorial on the subject of **MACCABIAH!**

I thank you too for your excellent letter to the Editor of the Jerusalem Post, which already brought about the desired results.

About your discussions with Lalkin. I wish to give you some inside information. You must be aware of the fact that the Israel Sports Federation is governed by a strong majority of Hapoel and almost all sports committees are in the hands of Hapoel people and to have all the heads of the sports committees in the hands of Hapoel people is certainly not desirable. There are other reasons too as to why we did not accept the proposal of the Sports Federation that it should organize the sports competitions. The reasons are as follows:-

- 1) Not always, in this Federation, are the best and most experienced people at the head of the various committees. Only Hapoel people. Quite a number of our own people are better and more experienced than these Hapoel people, but they cannot be Chairmen of Committees for political reasons.
- 2) The Chairmen of the respective sports committees are the heads of the Israeli delegation to the Maccabiah Games and they are responsible for the team. Therefore they are not free enough to work exclusively for the Maccabiah as they have to take care of the preparation of the Israeli team. It is absolutely necessary that the Chairmen of the

...../2

Maccabiah sports committee should be neutral, ones who are not connected with the Israeli team.

I think that you will accept my explanations.

There are certain cases where we have no choice, but to accept the best man available, as in the case of Tadir and two or three others as we have no better experts.

What you write about the Wingate pupils, we have already taken care of this matter.



Bodybuilding boss to visit Czechs

Back in 1946 when Montrealer Ben Weider founded the International Federation of Bodybuilders, little did he dream that it would develop into the largest bodybuilding organization of its kind in the world.

In the past 23 years, he has travelled to 97 countries to preach the gospel of building better bodies and now has 42 countries affiliated with the Federation.

A major achievement was created several years ago when the sport was introduced into all Soviet athletic institutions as a basis to build strength for other sports. Officials attributed the body building programs as a major reason for later successes of Soviet athletes in Olympic and international competitions.

Several years ago, Weider was invited by Nicolai Romano, sports minister of the Soviet Union and Chiang Lien Hua, sports minister of Red China, to visit their countries and exchange ideas on bodybuilding.

"Following the outstanding performances of athletes of these countries after taking up bodybuilding and weightlifting, coaches of the Western countries quickly introduced similar programs," said Ben.

Now, he reports another breakthrough. He has received an official invitation to spend two weeks in Czechoslovakia as a guest of the Czech Bodybuilding and Weightlifting Federation.

"Emile Mueller, president

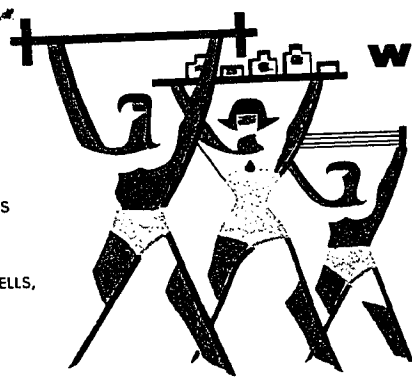
of the Czechoslovakian Federation, has asked for affiliation with IFBB and this brings great joy to me," said Weider.

"For many years the IFBB has been trying to get the Eastern European countries to accept bodybuilding, with little success. Now it looks as though the door is opening for us."

Weider says his two-week trip will include intensive travel and lectures and he intends to take this opportunity to press for affiliation of the Hungarian and Yugoslav bodybuilding movements to join up with the IFBB.

"If this can be done, my next step will be to seek acceptance by the International Olympic Committee. If I can achieve this objective, it will fulfill all my hopes for the sport," he concluded.



Dear Friends,

I am referring to the troubles for which I asked you to send the telegraphic protests. I have been obliged to fly immediately to Rome in order to avoid the split of the youth movements and some other complications. After a very long series of meetings and contacts with all communitary organisations, it has been possible to arrive to a diplomatic solution. Just to give an idea, I will remember you that some people had printed the imitation of our Maccabi official cards in order to have the right to vote and some other had started to collect money in my name and reading one of my appeals without my permission. They refused of course to give me that amount in the case I had not agreed with some proposals.

As the Council of Maccabi Rome was not 100% right (and in some details even wrong) I have induced all people of all sides to resign. An agreement with the Community has been concluded and I will nominate immediately a special Maccabi Commissar for Rome without external interference; but the actual President Luigi Polacco and the Treasurer Pavoncello will have the right to remain in charge until 10th August (after the end of the Maccabiah). The new enlarged Maccabi will start up after the return from Israel and the new Maccabi elections will be made inside 6 months. All groupments and all people have recognised the independence of M.W.U. and the authority in Italy of the Italian Maccabi Federation.

In the package of the agreement, which presents a little personal satisfaction, with your help, I have been compelled to accept the football participation at the Maccabiah requested by hundreds of fanatic supporters. You can easily understand what that will represent in the actual moment of difficult organisation.

I accepted at the condition that the football financial problem must be covered by a new collect in Rome. Unfortunately, owing to the high prices of the Maccabiah Village, the team of football, which will not fly with the official team as we have not sufficient reserved places, will organise the accomodation at cheaper conditions away, but

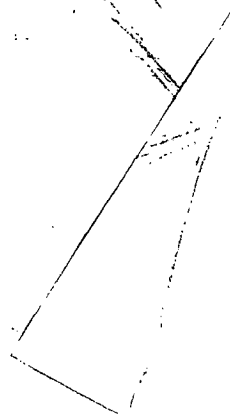

My dear Pierre,

I just now receive your letter of 12th inst., some of the arguments of which have been modified by our further exchange of letters.

- 1) The cost for each person is £ 166.- not included the expenses from the respective town to and from Rome;
- 2) the romans have now obtained as inclusive tour in hotel instead of Maccabi accomodations, for the footballers and supporters, a price of £ 100.-. It is therefore impossible to avoid the split of Italian team. I have drawn your attention and that of our friends during IMGC meeting on the effects of the too high prices of the official accomodations and of the result of the dollars 1.25 at the favour of the South Americans. I asked recently to Mr. Caspy to cancel Italy from the countries which must support the South American but he refused my request.
- 3) The other split which I am not in a position to avoid in the team is the choise of the price of 11 dollars for the athletes which will not pay and that of 13 dollars or even 15 dollars for those who will pay. But in this case the split will be made in the same and one official accomodation. I have been compelled to explain the origin of our very high prices because the parents refused to believe that the cost was of £ 166.-. Some of them accepted to pay provided we grant a good room and not the room of 12 beds. Please note, my very dear friend, that the practical difficulties are very different from our theoretical IMGC's decisions. That is the reason which induces me very often not to speak during Maccabi Congress or IMGC's meetings where all seems to be easy and obvious.
- 4) In every Maccabiah and also in the next one I will have with me some officials like the trainers of boxing and judo, the President of Maccabi Rome and other ones. The costs of some of these people are supported by Italian Maccabi Federation.

I thank you very much for the copies of our telegrams addressed respectively to the Union of Italian Jewish Communities and to the Jewish Community of Rome, the first one being the Federation of all Italian Communities and the second one being the Community which decided to consider suspended the Chairman Luigi Polacco and the Council of the Circolo Sportivo Maccabi Roma and to nominate Mr. Alberto Veneziani Special Commissar of that Club.

Before calling you I had telegraphed my own protests to both Presidents Mr. Sergio Piperno and Mr. Gianfranco Tedeschi. Now, in presence of a letter of the Community of Rome informing me that the decision was due to "a crisis of Maccabi Rome", I have answered with an energetic letter.

I know that some contacts had been operated in Rome by Mr. Ezrah Solimani, the President of Maccabi Livorno, who was in direct contact with Pierre. In Rome there are now many new immigrants from Africa (arrived after the Six Days' War) who are not familiar with Maccabi Rome, as this one is specialised only in judo. I was already examining with Luigi Polacco the possibility to extend the activity also to football or basket: the reason of our telegrams was always the financial question. In the meantime I started with the national collect for the Maccabiah and correctly I published every week in the Jewish Press the amounts received for the Italian Team.

When Roman people knew that I had in bank some money, they started (Livorno and the not yet Maccabi people of Rome) to advance their requests. But nobody of them send me just a symbolic cheque.

I have my ideas about the participation in the individual sports at the Maccabiah and I am against Italian football presence for many reasons: 1) it is too expensive; 2) the level is very poor; 3) in my contacts with the Olympic Committee I granted "quality and not quantity" and therefore I obtained more money than before; I am however obliged to spend well the money of the Olympic Committee and to avoid to

risk to present in football an official result Israel-Italy 20-0, the effect of which would be terrific, with complications for our future, and possible intervention of the Italian Embassy and Foreign Minister, as it happens when Italy is defeated abroad.

Owing to the roman situation I included in the Entry Form A an imaginary football team. It may be that roman people immaginated that I will not include football in the Entry Form B. They asked me to put at their disposal the money collected by me and have finally influenced the Community of Rome against the poor Maccabi Club Rome, which I must protect.

I will inform you about the development of the situation, but I am optimist being sure that your telegrams will have obtained to stop the interference.

Today I have sent you the following cable, in reply to your cable concerning a basketball referee:

"italian basketball referee stefanutti nominated by fiba not available stop inform us immediately if fornari sergio is internationally accredited and recommended by italian basketball federation stop if positive we invite on our expenses stop cable urgently - atlas"

We received information from the International Basketball Federation that they have nominated Mr. Stefanutti from Italy as chief referee for the Maccabiah basketball tournament. I now learn that Mr. Stefanutti is not able to come.

Mr. Fornari Sergio: I did not understand your cable. If this information from the Italian Basketball Federation on behalf of the fact that Mr. Stefanutti is not able to come? As indicated in my cable, we would accept this referee instead of Mr. Stefanutti provided that he is internationally accredited and sanctioned by the Italian Basketball Federation. We can accept this referee only if the conditions outlined are fulfilled, as we have to have an official referee from the F.I.B.A. for our basketball tournament. If Mr. Fornari is not sanctioned by the Basketball Federation, I would ask you to arrange for another officially, internationally accredited basketball referee for the Maccabiah Games. This matter is very urgent and I thank you in anticipation if you could ensure that we will have such a referee.

Shooting: We have noted your letter of June 27th about shooting.

Accommodation: Your various letters about accommodation are confusing. You are asking for some very good accommodation for some of your team members, even mentioning \$15, and for the rest you want \$11. Would you please enlighten me in this matter, exactly how many you want for \$15, for \$13 and for \$11, otherwise we cannot make satisfactory arrangements.

The \$11 clause, mentioned in my circular letter of June 18th, does not concern your team as you have indicated beforehand that you want accommodation for \$11, but as some countries didn't inform us about their accommodation requirements I had to inform them as I did.

All golfers will be accommodated in Caesarea. Please contact the Caesarea Golf Club about special requirements for your golfers, as there is still more expensive hotel accommodation available, but I am afraid that it is sold out. In any case they should make their arrangements through the Golf Club in Caesarea.

Dear Massimo,

Your letter of June 20th to England and myself has troubled me. You inform me that there will be a football team from Italy, composed mainly of players from Rome, who will have private accommodation. I wish to inform you that we, as a matter of principle, cannot hinder them in making their private arrangements, but in such a case we will not be responsible for their transportation and for the information about the Games which they have to play. We can be responsible for transportation only if it is within the framework of the general centers of accommodation for the various teams and if any team lives outside of the accommodation centers then this team has to take care of its own transportation, making sure that they are on time for the scheduled venue for their matches. Otherwise they will lose through default.

Please bring all this to the attention of your athletes and take care that they will make their own arrangements for being on time at the venues for their matches.

Your general remarks about the football tournament are correct and if you will remember well, I was the one who wanted to exclude football altogether from the Maccabiah, not only on behalf of the numbers of playing teams, but also on behalf of the low standard of play. You remember that I was heavily out-voted and if we must arrange a football tournament then I don't see any other way of doing it other than is usual at all other international tournaments. Your proposal for Continental teams did not have any support either and now we have to stick to the decisions of the I.M.G.C.

We have received the following cable from you:

Would you please explain the following immediately:-

- 1) The exact name and title of the gentleman.
- 2) His address.
- 3) Who will pay his travel expenses.
- 4) Who will pay for board and lodging and do you mean that we should reserve a room for him in the Sheraton Hotel, which is very expensive, or can it be a similar hotel of first class quality and for what period of time.

Please let us have these explanations, otherwise we cannot do anything. We cannot bear the expenses for a vice-secretary of an Olympic Committee. We would be honoured by the presence of Mr. Onesti and would pay for him in the Sheraton Hotel, but we need more explanations and information from you on this matter. Please inform us immediately.

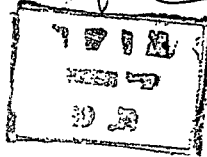



Dear Massimo,

Thank you for your letter of 6th June, contents of which I have immediately discussed with Ken Gradon, who replied to you on 10th June.

I agree with what he said in his letter to you, namely, that it would be inadvisable to split up your team in two separate Accommodation Centres. I also confirm my readiness to offer you £100 to £150 towards the cost of your team, providing that this subsidy will help you to bring some team officials who cannot otherwise defray part, or the whole, of their expenses. If you will be good enough to let me know your wishes, the rest will be done upon hearing from you.

Since you sent a copy of your letter of 6th June to Dr. Atlasz, he will gather from it that you do not hope, realistically, to be able to raise a team of more than 25, notwithstanding the fact that in Form "A" you have indicated 75 persons. I fear that such will be the case in many other countries who are working hard to raise funds, or who have great difficulty in selecting sportsmen worthy of competing in the Maccabiah.

Livorno. I have carefully noted your remarks on the subject of Mr. Schinasi and his Club and I fully subscribe to the policy which you adopt in connection therewith. Needless to say that I will not encourage Mr. Schinasi to write to me again and, should I receive a communication from him, I will refer him immediately to yourself, as I have done in my last letter, even without full knowledge of this man's character or previous behaviour.

Dear Ken,

Owing to the strike, I received only to-day your letter of 19th May.

From the enclosed card you will note that I have organized (with the very precious help of Adelina) a dinner for the Maccabiah. The net benefit has been of about USA \$ 1.000- In order to be present I have renounced to my professional duty to be present at the final of European Cup in Madrid. Unfortunately I have not yet concluded my contacts with a Brandy Factory on commercial basis for the Italian Team. With our national collect, included the dinner's benefit, I am now at about USA \$ 4.000- I am trying to organize through Maccabi Rome a cinema evening with a good film.

I have, however, some new difficulties with Maccabi Livorno, as Pierre will explain you, because his Chairman (always helped by me), is against the use of the money for the Maccabiah and is asking to distribute the collect between the Clubs for their usual activity.

For the first time I have to fight also inside in our organisation, and I have informed the Council that I will resign after the Maccabiah. The members of the Maccabi Milano have also preferred to follow home the football match of Madrid in television instead of coming to the dinner (where I had also placed, very well, a television).

Furthermore the roman footballers, not associated to Maccabi, have now protested against my decision not to include a football team for the Maccabiah and have decided to open another collect in concurrence with mine. I am against Italian football participation for two reasons: first, because a soccer team is too expensive; secondly because the level of our jewish footballers is of very poor quality. The roman group of footballers is organized by some North African Jews arrived in Italy after the Six Days War and it is very difficult to discuss with them or to induce them to recognize the Maccabi rules. I believe that I will be compelled to include in the Entry Form A also the football,

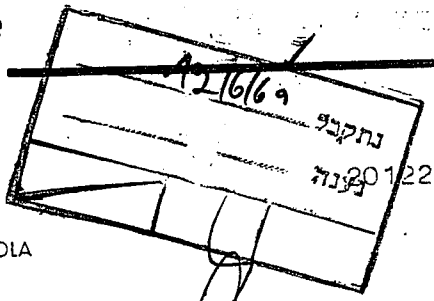

My dear Pierre,

I have received to-day your two letters of 21st and 28th May. The postal strike had a disastrous consequence on all your activities and has also paralised the Maccabiah preparation's work. Just to give you an idea we are receiving now April's circulars from Tel Aviv. The same is regarding all the letters exchanges with the athlets in all Italian towns and those with the Olympic Committee or with the Federations. Many and many millions of letters, telegrams, cheques are to be distributed from the Postal Office.

Livorno: I had of course all the documentation which you sent me now because Italian Federation is following daily all the activities of the Clubs. I am repeating that Mr. Baruh Schinasi has been created by me, and his Club has been always helped very much even if they have never cooperated for the Maccabiah. Just to give you an idea, all the contacts with jewish athlets of other Clubs of Livorno have been followed directly from Milan. Mr. Schinasi was of the opinion that only Maccabi members could be present at the Maccabiah, but Maccabi Livorno is specialised only in basketball and has not also a department of fencing or cycling or tennis. The basketball level of Livorno is poor and we cannot compete against USA or Israel. Furthermore Mr. Schinasi avoided to inform you that the best basket players of Maccabi Livorno are not Jews. I had with him a polemic owing to his decision to open the participation to not jewish athlets. Now this gentleman is trying to complicate the situation writing you and contacting other jewish groupments in Rome, and forgets to send me the receipts of the money which I personally remitted to his Club.

Maccabiah: I thank you very much for your help and your very appreciated "encouragement". I am very glad to inform you that I have obtained a good personal success with Italian Olympic Committee. As you know from my previous letter I arrived with the jewish national collect about to USA \$ 42000 (included my personal offer). Now I obtained from my friend Onesti, President of the CONI, (with whom I discussed the opportunity to renounce to the Maccabiah, owing to the fact that I have not concluded the commercial operation with some

Italian factories) a contribution of USA \$ 4.800, so that the total in bank is now increased to USA \$ 8.800. I remember you that for 1961 the CONI gave me one million lire; for 1965 two millions lire; and now three millions lire. An Italian participation is now granted and sure, even if I cannot say how many people will be present. In the Entry Form A I indicated 75 persons; I believe that the Entry Form B will reduce the people to 25, but I will continue my efforts in order to increase this number.

Accomodation: One of the problems is the accomodation price for two reasons. There are athlets who are very poor and other of good conditions. To the parents of these ones I am asking to pay. There are however other organisations, like Zionist Federation, Wizo, Ashomer Hatzair, and so on, which are organising travels in Israel at special and cheaper prices. The parents are protesting against the prices for the accomodation for the Maccabiah. Unfortunately some of them have expressed the opinion that Italian Maccabi is speculating and they don't understand that I have accepted the IMGC's decisions. Furthermore how to do with boys who have not paid and boys who will have paid? If I will give them the same accomodation I am sure that the parents will protest another time, and I am now afraid to be compelled to give separated accomodations of USA \$ 11 to the athlets free of charges and of USA \$ 13 to the athlets who pay. What do you suggest?

Athlets: Another difficulty is due to the fact that some athlets (the best ones) are on the Army and the Minister of Defence refuses to give them the permit to go in Israel. Unfortunately there are also some parents who refuse to permit to their sons to go to Israel owing to the political situation.

You will easily understand that with all these problems I don't like the polemics of Mr. Baruh Schinasi.



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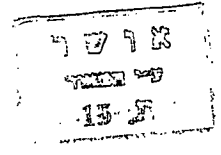

My dear Friend,

I have received your letter of 28th April. It is really impossible for me to give you some news about athletes, owing to the fact that this month I don't know how many people and which ones will be present at Maccabiah Games. It is not necessary that I explain another time to you and to your friends that I have a lot of troubles in finding the financial means. Furthermore many athletes are not yet sure to participate to the Maccabiah. For example, Flavio Asta, gold medal in discus 1965 and silver medal in shot-put, is at present "carabiniere" (military police). He wrote me recently that the headquarters refused to give him the permission to go in Israel, owing to the present military situation. I am in contact with Italian Athletics Federation in order to obtain, if possible, a special permission. For the same reasons the mother of Tedeschi, gold medal 1965 in cycling, is now refusing to agree with my request to have her boy at next Maccabiah.

It is therefore necessary that you await a few weeks before having other news, hoping that I will be able to collect money and to confirm the possibility to be present at next Maccabiah.





I hereby acknowledge your letter dated March 5th. You will receive, in the next days, a circular indicating the situation upon the receipt of replies to my questionnaire from 17 countries. All twenty sports will be carried out.

I await a final answer from all members of the I.M.G.C. about accommodation either on a sliding scale or on a general unified-price scale.

There is no question that teams will be split up. Only the golfers will live in Caesarea, near the golf course. All other teams will live in one place. However, you must be aware that we have to pay a very high price for the Ramat Aviv Hotel as this is a hotel in the luxury class and we cannot afford to ask for less than \$15 in the Ramat Aviv Hotel - in view of the fact that the I.M.G.C. meeting in November 1967 demanded that each team must pay an extra \$1.25 per capita and day in support of the South American countries, whose travel expenses are very very high in comparison to those of other countries.

Football: I appreciate your efforts and I am fully aware of the difficulties encountered in each country owing to the World Championships. We have no team until now and I eagerly await your announcement on your efforts.

Dear Massimo,

Football I am very sorry that you are so unfortunate with your drive for the Maccabiah and therefore I return to my appeal to you about an Italian football team. For the same reason that you write - the earlier beginning of the season on behalf of the football world championships - makes it so difficult for me to obtain a good team from any country and I don't see which attractive team I can invite other than an Italian one again. Perhaps you can persuade the football federation and one of the top Italian teams to make an exception and to treat this match in the Ramat Gan Stadium on August 7th 1969 as a training match. Torino and Juventus, at previous Maccabiahs, certainly did not strain themselves too much and it seemed to us that they really did not make a big effort to win, which ordinarily they should have done. For us it is sufficient if they will play in the same manner as they did before. Naturally the financial conditions for the team must be within our financial means and we will again make a reduction for ^{your} the Italian team accordingly.

Accommodation I am sending out a Circular Letter to all members of the I.M.C.C. explaining to them the situation and asking for their opinion. From this you will be aware of how the financial situation for accommodation may be handled and I await the outcome of the replies. This will also answer your request about the accommodation of your team at the Ramat-Aviv Hotel.

Rowing If you have rowers to enter the competitions at the Maccabiah then you don't need to bother about boats. These will be given by the Organizing Committee. From your letter I see that you intend to send two rowers to participate in the single scull and in the double sculls. Concerning a coxswain, I shall investigate this with the Rowing Committee, but I don't think that this will make any difference.

However, I shall inform you about this later. As a matter of principle and according to the international rules, a boat's crew must be composed of members of the same nationality.

Dear Robert,

The result of the first collect has been disastrously poor: less than 200 dollars. As I had promised to publish on the Jewish Press the list and the total, I have personally covered, on the name of the Italian Federation and on my name the difference of 800 dollars, just in order to inform the public that "we have already 1000 dollars" and that we are in a position to invite all people to increase the amount. As you see, I am always dreaming.

May I know how much will cost this year the various accomodations indicated in the Maccabiah Bulletin N. 6/7?

As far as your request of a football match is concerned I am following the situation, but, as I have informed you in Mexico, all depends from the date of the next championship. It may be that the beginning of the season will be anticipate in view of the World Cup of Mexico 1970. With the usual dates of Italian seasons it would not be possible to obtain a permit for a match on 7th August. Generally the activity is prohibited during July and the first two weeks of August. The professional teams are starting with training on 15th or even 20th August, but it may be that this year an anticipation will be decided. It is not sure however that Juventus or Cagliari or Milan does accept to play away and in an international meeting, because they usually are starting against Italian amateur little Clubs in very easy matches.

Another question: could you grant me the use of a single scull and/or a double scull? I have two athlets for Rowing, but I cannot have also the imbarcations, the shipment of which is very expensive. If you have not a useful double scull, have you a "pair oar", with a young Israeli boy as cox? I have the athlets, but not the cox.

We are referring to your circulars of January 29th, February 2nd and 6th.

Accommodation: we are interested to the Ramat Aviv Hotel's accommodation because the proprietors are Italian. Will you give us an idea of the price?

Attachés-Liason Officers: we will inform you as soon we will have a reply requested to Jerusalem.

Referees: owing to the financial situation we will not be in a position to support the expenses for referees.

Cultural Events: we have not the possibility to prepare part of our team for folk singing because the athletes, provided we find the money for a large participation, are from many different towns.

Press informations and Questionnaire: for the reasons which you know, we are obliged to see which will be our possibility to send a team for the next Maccabiah. The "volunteers" who are prepared to pay their travel are, of course, of third quality (golf, tennis, ping pong, shooting); the best ones (judo, boxing, cycling, swimming, diving) are poor and we must collect money; the other sport (football, basket, volleyball) are too expensive; some other athletes (athletic, gymnastic, rowing, fencing) know that we need their participation and that we will pay for them. In these conditions, and with all our problems, it is impossible, for the moment, to reply to the questionnaire and to give you some news for the Press Dept.

Should we have the money of Americans, we could send in Israel a Delegation of 100 athletes, some of them of not bad quality.

Dear Theo,

I don't understand about Mr. Gruel. Has the French Federation of Judo appointed him as an official referee? We didn't ask for him as we already have the Chairman of the International Judo Federation coming as chief referee for the Judo events. We can only accept him together with the other referees that you mention in your team: Mr. Schwalb - Metz, Mr. Bitton - Montpellier, Mr. Demeusy - Strasbourg and including Mr. Bismuth. This, provided that they will be accommodated together with your team, as special accommodation prices in hotels are too high for us and are connected too with special transportation.

I refer also to my former letters that we can use these referees only if they have internationally recognized credentials. This is important and we can make arrangements for them only under the above-mentioned conditions.

We have taken note of your requests for tickets for the Opening and Closing Ceremonies, but I wish to emphasize that only for Mr & Mrs. Haas and for Mr & Mrs Poch can we provide free tickets in the official stands. All others must pay for their places. As far as places for the referees are concerned with, we shall give them seats together with the other referees.

We shall see Mrs. Poch and her son after their arrival and you will certainly contact us when you arrive too.

Dear Mr. Poch,

Thank you for your letter of June 20th. It certainly was a misunderstanding about the arrivals.

We will see to it that somebody will be at the port when Madame Poch and her son arrive in Haifa and extend all help, concerning the Customs, with your car, the balls and the flags. Please do remember that it must be declared at Customs that the balls are for the training of the French team and that the flags are the personal equipment of the French team, which they will take back with them after the Maccabiah. Otherwise we will have to pay Customs charges for both these items. Our representative at the port will explain all these matters to the Customs officials.

With your letter we received the pictures of yourself, Madame Poch and Mr. Morand but I do not think that it will be practical to send the Identity Cards to Metz. You will receive them upon your arrival here.

I regret very much that you cannot send Entry Forms B earlier, as this will complicate matters very much in organisation, but I understand your position and can only ask you again to send them by express air mail immediately.



Entry Forms: We have received your Entry Forms A and I am really impressed by the big number of participants you are sending to the 8th Maccabiah Games, even though this gives me tremendous headaches in connection with accommodation.

Accommodation: You should realize that we do not have so many places of accommodation for \$11 per capita and day and most countries are asking for the same convenience.

As I have indicated to you in my circular letter about accommodation, there will be a neutral committee which will decide about the distribution of the teams, taking into consideration the fees which they are able to pay. It certainly is not possible for us to put 600 people into the dormitories of the Maccabiah Village, which cost \$11 and where we have only 250 beds available. We will have to find some solution without breaking up any team as we absolutely want to house each team together in one place.

Equipment: I am satisfied that you will bring with you the 10 flags and the 10 balls for handball when you arrive by ship.

I learn from a letter from Mr. Poch (June 9th) that you and Madame Poch will arrive with the SS Dan on July 14th in Haifa. We will arrange that somebody will be present at the port to help you through the Customs. It is very important that you declare that these balls are the personal equipment of your team for training purposes. Otherwise we must pay customs fees for the balls.

Referees: I take note that you can send us 4 referees, as follows:- Mr. Schwalb from Metz (Football) - Mr. Bitton from Montpellier (Volleyball) - Mr. Bismuth from Nice (Swimming and Water Polo) - Mr. Demeusy from Strassburg (Handball).

We are able to use referees only if they have an internationally accredited permit to act as judges in international tournaments. If they are not internationally recognized referees then we are not allowed to use them and we cannot bear any expenses for them. If you can assure us that these gentlemen have the necessary credentials then we will take care of their board and lodging, together with your team.

Beds: I take note that you have 14 members of your team, taller than 1.86 meters, for whom we shall provide longer beds.

I trust to receive your Entry Forms B by July 8th 1969 at the latest, otherwise we cannot guarantee smooth accommodation for your team. Please make sure that pictures of members of your team are included with Entry Forms B.

The pictures of Mr & Mrs. Poch and Mr. Poch-Morand were not included in the letter. We shall give you the Identity Cards after your arrival in the country.

Finally, I am very much impressed by the spirit in which you are preparing your team for the Games and, as a matter of fact, the most important thing at the Maccabiah is to participate and not to win medals. For the purpose of publicity and the standard of the Games, it would be most valuable if you have some outstanding athletes in your team. In case of this, please indicate names. But if you leave such people, who are not interested in the participation at the Games and only want to be "stars", at home then it is alright too.

Dear Mr. Poch,

Thank you for your letter dated May 9th, in which you inform us that the French Maccabiah team will consist of 84 male participants and 12 officials, to be housed in the Maccabiah Village.

Until now we have received so many requests for housing in the Maccabiah Village that it is physically impossible to give all the teams the accommodation in the Maccabiah Village for which they are asking.

A committee, consisting of 4 persons, - one from South Africa, one from Denmark, one from Argentina and one from Israel - will make the necessary arrangements for housing the teams and at this moment we cannot promise anything to any country about a definite appropriation.

You will have seen from my circular letter about the accommodation that we have five different places for accommodation which, together, have a maximum capacity for 1140 beds. Until now we have already received requests for the entry of 1250 athletes and officials. It will be extremely difficult to make the necessary arrangements for all the teams and it is possible that we will have to look for additional, alternative accommodation places. I shall give our Accommodation Committee your request about housing, but the final decision about the placing of your team will be made by the above mentioned Committee.

I eagerly await the arrival of Entry Forms A from you in order to know exactly in which sports your teams will compete. It would be important too for you to let us know if you have some internationally authorized referees who could be judges in the ball games.

I have taken note that Mr. Bismuth from Nice will be a referee for the swimming and water polo events and it is necessary that he and every referee brings with him his official credentials.

I have another very urgent and important request, concerning equipment. We need urgently for the handball tournament, 10 balls of Hungarian make but made in France. We will reimburse you for the cost of these balls. Would you please be kind enough to confirm to me that you will bring these balls with your team.



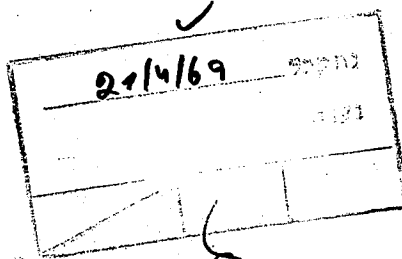

We don't insist that this rule should be strictly observed by every country, but we need at least a minimum number of referees for the different ball games in order to have a neutral refereeing assured at these tournaments.

- Would you please inform me what kind of referees you could bring with you and if it would ~~not~~ be a referee of international standard, of which we are in need, we will defray the costs of board and lodging for him but certainly not the travel expenses, which must be borne by your team.

Tennis: I fully understand your approach in the case of Mr & Mrs. Darmon and I agree with you and I will be very happy if you could assure the participation of the Salfati sisters.

Your remark about the quality of your team is a very important one. It is the right spirit which we want to impress upon every Territorial Organisation, that it is not the winning of medals which is important but participation at the Maccabiah and the close contact with Israel and Judaism, for which the Maccabiah is one of the most important means.



It is very regrettable that you have no other athletes for the Maccabiah Games and that Ireland will be represented only at the Opening and Closing Ceremonies and not in any official competitions.
