I would like to take this opportunity to tell you about the progress we made during the 1983-84 season.

Besides our regular programs, (involving over 700 kids and adults) Maccabee A.C. expanded and formed Club Soccer, Club Basketball and Adult Basketball teams which participate in regional leagues.

Our club teams, participating in leagues all over Southern California, will give our talented kids a chance to advance and develop their skills while spreading the Maccabee message.

In the Adult Basketball programs, the Maccabee club is now sponsoring a collegiate league made up of eight teams, of Hillel students from eight different campuses in the southland.

We welcome the Hillel students and hope their program will grow stronger.

Another major development is the delegation the Maccabee club is sending to Detroit, to represent our Jewish community in the North American Mini Maccabia Games for youth ages 12 to 16. This is a major Jewish event for youngsters and we will be represented with 50 kids taking part in Soccer, Basketball, Swimming, Tennis and Track.

During the Olympic Games comming up this summer, Maccabee A.C. will take an active part in hosting and assisting the Israeli delegation.

Our rapid growth is largely due to the dedicated volunteers serving on our committees and board of directors, the coaches, Referees, Team Mothers and the dedicated ladies of our Womens Auxiliary division.

MACCABEE TRADITION

MACCABEE AND JEWISH TRADITION



The Maccabee Youth Organization was founded in 1895 when young European Jews were involved in the growing movement for a national home in Eretz, Israel. Those youngsters believed that one essential prerequisite for the Jewish national renaissance was the improvement of the physique of the ghetto youth. To that end, Maccabee established gymnastics clubs in a number of Eastern and Central European countries.

The concept of a nationalist sports movement received an even greater impetus in 1898 from a stirring address by the well-known Zionist leader, philosopher and physician, Max Nordan, at the second Zionist Congress in Basle in which he proclaimed:

"... gymnastics and physical training are exceedingly important for us Jews, whose greatest defect has been and is a lack of discipline... nature has endowed us with the spiritual qualities required for athletic achievements of an extraordinary quality. All we lack is muscle, and that can be developed with the aid of physical exercise... The more Jews achieve in the various branches of sport, the greater will be their self-confidence and self-respect."

The truth of Nordan's contention was demonstrated in 1903 at the fourth Zionist Congress in Basle, where a group of 35 outstanding gymnasts from various European clubs staged an impressive display. It was at this Congress that the foundations were laid for the Union of Jewish Gymnastics clubs — Maccabee, later called Maccabee World Union.

Today the Maccabee movement has a world membership of hundreds of thousands with branches located in practically every Jewish community in the free world.

The establishment of Maccabee clubs in the United States, as well as in other countries, aims at the physical and

character development of young men and women, enabling them to contribute not only to improving Jewish life, but also to making better American citizens.

Although Maccabee is a youth sports organization, it is somehow different in its' conception from other similar organizations. It is true that "mens sana in corpore sano," as it is expressed in Latin which means that a healthy mind is possible in a healthy body; but according to Jewish tradition, the opposite is also true, namely that a healthy body is not possible if there is not previously a healthy mind. Our ancient scholars therefore proclaimed: "Take care of your mind for thus you will surely be freed from bodily illness."

But Jewish tradition goes still further than this. Inasmuch as every individual is a member of a social group or a people, it follows that every ethical system contains a number of duties covering the relation between him and the group. These duties are of a double aspect, duties of the individual toward the group, and duties of the group toward the individual. Judaism lays great stress upon their fulfillment. Dispersed as the Jews were during a great part of their history, and subject to all kinds of suffering and tribulations, they could not have survived were it not for the fact that the fulfillment of these duties in both aspects was insisted upon in the most rigorous manner.

Jewish tradition demands not only the mechanical performance of certain public duties, but also an inner and whole-hearted interest in the fate of the people as a whole. For such feeling, great reward is promised, namely that one who identifies himself with the fate of the nation as a whole will live to participate in the comfort and joy that will come to the people.

It should also be emphasized that the duty of the individual toward the nation as a whole is so to act that his actions in no way reflect unfavorably on the name of the

group. In other words, he must know that the group is held responsible for the actions of its' individuals. That is why our scholars of the Talmud used to say that all Jews are responsible for one another. The life of our people in dispersion through the millennia very much resembled a journey in a boat on a stormy sea, and every slight leak in the boat might be the cause of danger to all the travelers.

I referred until now to the duties of the individual toward his community. The duties of the community toward the individuals of whom it is composed cover a whole range of actions, the performance of which can be accomplished in modern times only by an organized community. The most important of them all is the endeavor by the community to provide an adequate education, both physical and spiritual, for the children of its' members. When properly performed, it is the best guarantee for the survival of the community, or rather the nation as a whole. According to Jewish tradition, each Jew has the sacred duty to educate his children and transmit to them the cultural values of Judaism. The most important function of the Jewish communities throughout the "diaspora" is to provide education and means of physical,

intellectual and moral progress for its' children.

This is the deeper meaning of Maccabee. Maccabee means not only sports, it involves a whole philosophy of life that endeavors to reach the improvement and perfecting of the individual in all aspects of life. This ideal of Maccabee has lasted for a long time and will be ever-lasting.

The medieval poet and philosopher Judah Halevi has his protagonist declare in the book of the Kuzari that "Israel among the nations is like the heart among the members of the body, stronger and healthier than all of them." If we take into consideration that to the ancient Hebrews, the heart was the seat of mental and emotional as well as physical activity, perhaps it is not too fanciful to suggest translating Halevi's statement into modern terms, that "Maccabee is among the Jewish people like the heart among the members of the body, stronger and healthier than all of them." And if this is true, let us do our best to live up to this principle. Let's support Maccabee and evolve to feel a need to belong to something larger than ourselves. Maccabee we need you.

Maccabee Los Angeles 37 Years of a Proud History

In 1945, a small group of Jewish sports minded men, from the old Hakoah Vienna, under the leadership of Carl Rittigstein organized the Hakoah Los Angeles chapter. Among the activities of this club were soccer, gymnastics, swimming, skiing, and tennis for both men and women. In soccer, two teams were organized, the Hakoah, and the Maccabess. After the dissolution of the Hakoah Club, some of its players, among them was Ben Hochman, our chairman of the board, formed the Maccabee Athletic Club, as we know it today.

The Maccabee Athletic Club, Inc., a non-profit organization, is a voluntary association of men and women. It is a system of moral conduct, in fact, a way of life to many of our members and volunteers. The Maccabees seek to make good people better and those underprivileged a chance to compete in life. It teaches morality through symbolism and strives for better understanding among mankind through scholarships for sport and many other philanthropic social and cultural activities.

Maccabee Los Angeles is affiliated with Maccabee World Union, who sponsor and organize the Maccabiah games, being held in Israel every four years.

Throughout the years the club organized and sponsored many sports events: In 1948 the visit of the Hapoel soccer team at the old Gilmore Stadium in Los Angeles, a capacity crowd of 15,000 and several thousands had to be turned away.

The International Sports Festival in 1965, organized by the Maccabees and the Los Angeles Eilat Sister City Committee; a track and field meet and a soccer game vs. the Baja

Cal. All Stars. Proceeds of that important event were used for the purchase of desperately needed physical education equipment for the 1500 children of Eilat, our sister city.

In 1968 the Israel National Soccer team, on their way to the Mexico City Olympics, stopped off in Los Angeles for a charity game with the California All Stars. Proceeds of that event in the thousands of dollars were sent to Israel. This was again duplicated in 1970 when Israel qualified for the Soccer World Cup Games in Mexico City.

Since 1922, the Maccabee soccer team has developed into a top amateur team, and won many championships: Seven league titles in the L.A. Soccer League, one of the nation's strongest; five times U.S. Open Challenge Championships; twice the California State Cup (1982). We have also the two times championship Junior Team under the direction and coaching of Boris Koshebrowsky.

Our youth activities began back in 1967. But, this program exploded in the past four years to include as many as 500 children both in the San Fernando Valley and Los Angeles. We have had two soccer leagues, a club soccer team and for the past two seasons a basketball league. All these activities were the dream come true of Carl Rittigstein, who founded the youth program and was very active in its development, until his death last year.

But, all this is just a beginning . . . with your help and support, we look forward to many more years of sports activities and to additional programs to our youth club.

קצת היסטוריה על 37 שנות מכבי בלוס אנג'לס

הותיקים ודאי וזכרים ארועים כמו ביקור נבחרת הכדורגל של הפועל באיצטדיון גילמור הישן ב־1948; או את פסטיבל הספורט שאורגן ב־1965 במשותף על ידי מכבי לוס אנג'לס ועל ידי עיריית אילת. הכנסות המשחקים אז היו קודש לקניית ציוד לחינוך גופני עבור 1500 ילדי אילת, העיר התאומה של לוס אנג'לס.

ב־1968, אורגן ארוע מיוחד על ידי מכבי לוס אנג'לס: נבחרת הכדורגל של ישראל, בדרכה למשחקים האולימפיים במכסיקו, עצרה בלוס אנג'לס למשחק ידידותי עם קבוצת כוכבי קליפורניה. הכנסות משחק זה שהגיעו לאלפי דולרים נשלחו לישראל.

ארוע דומה נערך גם ב־1970, כשהפעילה ישראל למשחקי גמר הגביע העולמי בכדורגל במכסיקו סיטי.

השגי מכבי לוס אנג'לס בתחום הכדורגל הם ללא תקדים בקרב המועדונים החצי מקצועניים. ברחבי ארה"ב התפרסמה מכבי כקבוצה היהודית החצי מקצוענית היחידה שזכתה באליפויות לאומיות. ב־11 השנים האחרונות זכתה הקבוצה הבוגרת, המורכבת ברובה משחקנים ישראלים, ב־4 אליפויות ארציות של ארה"ב בכדורגל, ב־2 אליפויות של מדינת קליפורניה וב־6 אליפויות של הליגה החצי מקצוענית.

ב־4 השנים האחרונות זוכה מועדון מכבי לוס אנג'לס להכרה של הקהילה היהודית המקומית. תהליך זה הביא להקמת תכנית יחודית של ליגת כדורגל לנוער יהודי, מדי יום ראשון משחקים למעלה מ־500 ילדים ובני נוער בפארק בלבוא שבאנסינו ובפרפקס הי סקול. קארל ריטגסטין ז"ל

קבוצה קטנה של שוחרי ספורט יהודיים יוצאי הכח וינה הקימה ב־1945 סניף של הכח בלוס אנג'לס. החברים עסקו בפעילויות ספורט כמו כדורגל, התעמלות, שחיה, סקי וטניס.

בענף הכדורגל הוקמו 2 קבוצות: האחת נקראה הכח לוס אנג'לס והשנייה שחקת תחת דגל מכבי בהנהגתו של קרל ריטגסטין המנוח, שהלך לעולמו לפני מספר חדשים.

מתוך קבוצה זו של מכבי נוסד ב־1947 מועדון Maccabee Athletic Club, שהשנה ימלאו לו 35 שנים. מעטים מהמייסדים עדיין פועלים גם כיום. מועדון האתלטיקה של מכבי לוס אנג'לס הוא אירגון שלא למטרות רווח. זהו איגוד של נשים וגברים על בסיס התנדבותי. מכבי אינו רק מועדון כדורגל וספורט אלא מערכת של התנהגות מוסרית של ספורטאים יהודיים. ניתן אף לכנות זאת כדרך חיים. רוח מכבי קוראת להבנה הדדית בין בני אדם.

פעולות הספורט והחברה הן על בסיס התנדבותי כשהספורטאים הנוקיים זוכים למלגות לימודים והשתלמות. סיסמת המכבים: "נפש בריאה בגוף בריא" היא אם כן משקפת וקולעת. מכבי פרושו לא רק גוף חזק אלא מחויבות והודדות עם מסורת יהודית וגאווה יהודית.

חברי מכבי לוס אנג'לס גאים בהשגים הרבים של המועדון. השגים אלה – ומייד אמנה חלק מהם – אינם נעשים במאליהם. יש צורך בפעילים מסורים שיכירו בחשיבות ובנחיצות של אירגון כמו מכבי, במיוחד כאן בגולת אמריקה, כדי לסייע לאגודה להגשים את מטרותיה.

שהגה את הרעיון, יצר קשרים עם 30 בתי ספר ואירגונים יהודיים המשתתפים ומסייעים לתכנית הכדורגל לילדים. כל הפעילויות נערכות ביום ראשון בלבד, כדי שגם ילדים שומרי מצוות יוכלו להשתתף. שמות הקבוצות של הילדים בוודאי מרמזים על הזיקה לישראל, לדוגמא: צה"ל, פלמ"ח, גולן, נשר ת"א, אלופי בת ים וכו'.

מועדון מכבי מתכוון להמשיך ולהרחיב תכנית זו ובאמצעותה לשמור על יהדותם וזהותם של הילדים. מטרת מכבי ליצור תנועת נוער שחבריה ישתתפו בתחומים שונים של ספורט. יש להעניק לנוער – שהוא עתיד הקהילה, מסגרת שתשלב ספורט עם אהבת ישראל, רוח תחרות עם הגאווה של היותך ספורטאי יהודי. היעד הסופי הוא להפוך לזרוע הספורט של הקהילה היהודית המקומית. כבר כיום מכבי הוא אירגון הספורט היהודי הגדול ביותר בארה"ב.

כל מי שביקר בימי ראשון בצהריים בכלבוא פארק או פרפקס הי סקול, נוכח עד כמה מצליחה התכנית להלהיב את הילדים ובני הנוער, ולסחוף בהתלהבות גם רבים מההורים המצטרפים בקריאות עידוד או משתלבים באמון הקבוצות ובתפקידי ניהול ופיקוח.

דומה שמיותר לציין כי ליגת הילדים זקוקה למתנדבים מסורים ולסיוע נוסף.

במכבי מקווים שמקרב הילדים יצמחו שחקני העתיד של הקבוצה שישתלבו בין כוכבי הקבוצה הבוגרת. כיום מורכבת הקבוצה הבוגרת ברובה משחקנים מצטיינים שבאו מישראל, כמו אייל אפגין, יהודה גרגיר, קובי דרך, דני אפרגן ואחרים. בשנה האחרונה הפך איצטדיון בירמינגהם היי שבון נייס למגרשה הביתי של הקבוצה הבוגרת של מכבי.

כדורגל לבוגרים וילדים אינו ענף הספורט היחיד של מועדון מכבי. לאחרונה החלה האגודה לפתח גם תחומי ספורט נוספים כמו כדורסל וכן להקדיש מחשבה לענפי הטניס, השחייה ועוד.

הליגה לכדורגל פתוחה לבנים ולבנות בגילים 6 – 14, וגם משחקי ליגה זו נערכים בימי ראשון בבית הספר התיכון מל-הולנד שבון נייס. ליגת הכדורסל תחל בפעולות מיד לאחר ליגת הילדים בכדורגל, בתחילת חודש אוקטובר. אגודת מכבי מתכוונת לרכוש ציוד למשחקי טניס ולתחרויות שחיה.

אנשי מכבי חולמים כבר שנים על הקמת בית מכבי שיהיה מרכז ספורט מקיף שירכז את כל הפעילויות הללו.

לא כל ילד ולא כל זוג הורים יכולים להרשות לבנם אפילו מכנסי ספורט או זוג נעלי טניס חדשות. מכבי צריך לספק לאלה מחבריו הצעירים שאינם בעלי יכולת, את הציוד המתאים. בגילים הצעירים בהם גדלים הילדים הם ניתנים להשפעה, להכוונה ולשכנוע. חובתנו להקנות להם תחושת זהות, גאווה ספורטאית ורוח יהודית אמיצה ללא התחשבות במחיר. שום מחיר אינו גבוה מדי כשהאלטרנטיבה היא שוטטות של ילדים ברחובות.

ולסיום, הנהלת מכבי לוס אנג'לס מודה לכל אלה שתורמים ומסייעים לאגודה במשך כל השנים. אנו מקווים שתמשיכו לעשות כך גם בעתיד.

leaders and volunteers. Upon my experience with the club thus far, I would like to address several points regarding the relationship between the club, Judaism and education.

This year we have successfully expanded the club sports program to include more than 600 children in addition to some 100 High School, College and Adults participants who play on club teams.

The club's slogan has always been "OUR YOUTH IS OUR FUTURE." In this regard we must devote considerable attention to our young participants.

Club activities take place on Sundays only, so that observant and non-observant children may participate together, without regard to which synagogue, movement or community they belong to.

In my opinion, there are few organizations in Los Angeles that can take such pride in activities which attract so many participants and which, as a result of an interest in sports, provide a common ground for Jewish Youth.

In conjunction with the club's sports programs, the club must help bring Jewish Youth to a Jewish and Zionist framework. With the help of Jewish and Zionist education, together with the excitement of participation in sports activities, it will be possible to reach many Jewish Youth who have no connection with this framework.

As a Jewish sports club, we are obligated to fight the assimilation which today poses a real threat to the existence of the Jewish people. Educational activities regarding the unity of the Jewish people and the central place of Israel in Jewish life will serve to strengthen the club as it has the entire Maccabee movement. Although the provision of such educational activities requires an expenditure of funds, we must see them not as an expense, but rather as an investment for the future. We must see sports as an educational tool, and not as a goal in and of itself.

Sports may be used as an educational tool in several ways:

- 1) To encourage the participation in Maccabee games all over the world.
 - 2) To encourage Jewish Youth to participate in Maccabee Summer programs in Israel, of which a major part is sports activities.
 - 3) To encourage Jewish Youth and their parents to participate in Jewish Holidays and Festivals such as Israel Independence Day and in the Maccabee Chanukah Torch Celebration (Chanukah symbolizes the historical connection between the Maccabees of the past and the Maccabees of today).
 - 4) To establish an archive of material and photographs which embody the history of the club.
 - 5) To cultivate young leadership with entrusted responsibility of developing sports activities.
- The club should consider the following additional projects:
- A) To publicize the club's success in order to further expand support for and participation in club activities.
 - B) To broaden the scope of activities among High School and College students.
 - C) To open several new branches of sports such as Track and Field, Swimming, Gymnastics, Baseball and others.
 - D) To work vigorously to establish a Youth Movement to be called Young Maccabee.
 - E) To train counselors to direct the activities of the youth movement.
 - F) To work vigorously to establish a Maccabee Club house in Los Angeles that will be a center for youth and adult activities.
 - G) To publish a monthly newsletter to provide a forum for athletes to express themselves.
 - H) To strengthen our relationship with United States Committee Sport for Israel (U.S.C.S.F.I.).
 - I) To strengthen our relationship with Jewish Federation Council and to gain acceptance as its sports wing.
 - J) To strengthen our relationship with the Maccabee World Union and with Maccabee Clubs throughout the world.

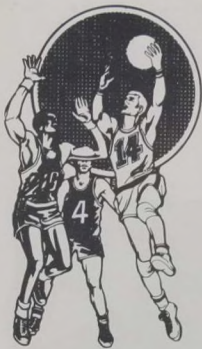
