NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN ZIONIST ORGANIZATION AND MACCABI W. U. SUCCESSFUL!

A 20 year old dream of our President Schicko Torczyner is finally coming true! In the last few weeks several meetings took place in New York between Mr. PIERRE GILDESGAME, Chairman of the Maccabi World Union and Mr. JACQUES TORCZYNER, National President of the Zionist Organization of America. A basic agreement was reached for a close cooperation between these two organizations on the American scene with the ZOA planning to organize some new Maccabi Clubs within the frame work of their Youth Program (including Young Judaea). The National Board of the ZOA ratified this plan just a few days ago and the first new Maccabi Clubs will be founded in Houston and Pittsburg in the near future.

At the end of this month "Schicko" is going East where he will have several meetings with the leaders of the Zionist Organization and of the Maccabi to advance these most important plans.

20TH ANNIVERSARY GALA AFFAIR POSTPONED TO MARCH, 1967!

Inspite of the tremendous interest shown among our members and friends we are postponing our 20th Anniversary Dinner Dance to March, 1967. There are several reasons for this. Organizing the U. S.
