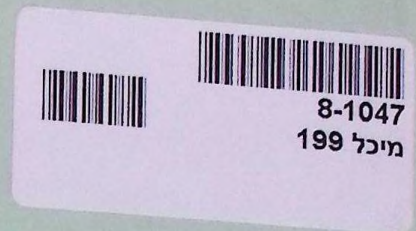

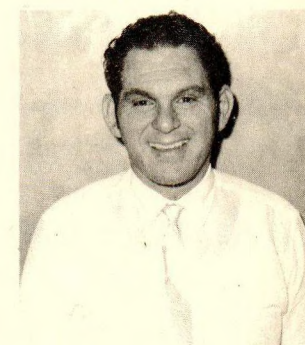
It is with pleasure that as W.A. Maccabi President I welcome participants and visitors to our State for the 37th Australian Maccabi Sports Carnival.

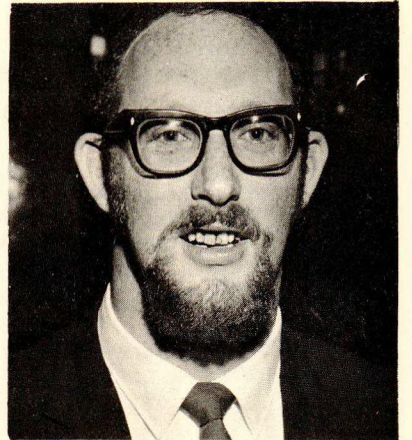

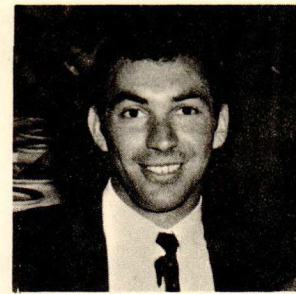

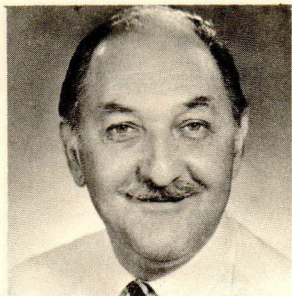
