




Those of my team who have come are keen to meet their counterparts from other states and make many friendships that I am sure will be long lasting.

General Information



IDENTITY CARDS - Photographic identity Cards will be issued to all registered team members. If a card is lost it must be reported immediately to that person's Team Manager. Team members must wear their I.D. cards at all times. Team members are advised that the transfer of I.D. Cards is **STRICTLY FORBIDDEN**. Your I.D. Card will give you entry to all sporting and social events. If you do not have your I.D. Card with you, you may be required to pay for entry at the Carnival Manager's discretion.

OFFICIAL UNIFORMS - Each team member must wear the appropriate official uniform at the Opening Ceremony and at Shabbat Services.

TEAM DISCIPLINE - Matters of team discipline will be first handled by the Section Manager of the sport concerned. If it is, however, of a serious nature, the matter will be referred immediately to team and Carnival Management.

NON-TICKET HOLDERS - Admission will be available to all functions and events at the relevant venue at notified prices, with the exception of the Team's Only Function.

CARNIVAL COMMITTEE - Members will be wearing a distinctive uniform of white shirt with Carnival logo, and tracksuit.

PHOTOGRAPHY - Photographs of teams, sports and social events will be taken by the Carnival Photographer. You may select two photos during Carnival at no cost, and order more at any time.

COMMUNICATION - This Carnival has a most comprehensive network of communications. All States have been allocated pagers, the contact numbers of which are to be found in the Carnival Directory at the back of the Programme Insert. For those of you who are unfamiliar with their operation, they are very simple to use. If you want to contact a person by pager, simply ring the number allocated and give the operator the person's name and message you wish to transmit. The message will then be transmitted to the selected pager. State Managers and several officials will be equipped with mobile phones and those details also will be found in the Directory. We ask you to make use of the facilities sensibly.



Guidelines for Billetors



During the Junior Carnival you will be acting as surrogate parents to an interstate visitor and to assist you here are some rules the competitors have been made aware of:

- 1 No competitor is permitted to travel on any form of public transport, including taxis, during the Carnival. You must ensure that you transport your billet and/or child to and from all venues by private transport. It is suggested that rosters can be formed with other team members.
- 2 It is very encouraging both to your own child and to the billet if you come to the events whenever possible. Please urge your billet and your family to attend other events to support their respective teams.
- 3 Non-prescribed Drugs, Alcohol and Smoking are banned. Any child violating this rule will be sent home at once and N.S.W. participants will be withdrawn from Carnival. Please help us enforce these rules.
- 4 There is a curfew during Carnival requiring all competitors to be home no later than midnight or one hour after completion of the last event. Kings Cross and surrounding areas are totally off limits to all participants at all times.
- 5 Competitors are required to be at their event at least fifteen minutes before scheduled starting time.
- 6 I.D. cards must be carried at all times, please remind all participants to have it with them.
- 7 It is compulsory for ALL Carnival participants to attend in uniform the Shabbat Service on the Friday night during Carnival at the Great Synagogue, Elizabeth Street, Sydney. We urge parents to attend and boys must wear kippot.
- 8 In this programme there is a list of Honorary Medical Officers who bulk bill. After hours however, we suggest you contact your own doctor and in all cases notify the State Team Manager.
- 9 During the free time of the Carnival please show your billet the sights of Sydney.
- 10 Don't forget to remind your billet and your child that on particularly hot days sunscreens and hats should be worn. Thank you for participating in the 10th Junior Carnival. We hope you and your family will have a wonderful experience.



The Jocelyn Kann Memorial Flame



The spirit and ideals of Maccabi Junior Sports Carnivals is to promote understanding, friendship and sportsmanship among the Jewish youth of Australia. No one person was a finer example of these ideals than the late Jocelyn Kann. She was a Queensland Maccabi Life Member and President, the first Lady in Australia to receive these honours.

Dedicated on 7th January, 1987 this 50cm high torch was first used to open the 5th Junior Sports Carnival. The Jocelyn Kann Memorial Flame is dedicated to the blessed memory of one of Queensland Maccabi's proudest daughters, whose untimely death robbed Maccabi of a joyful and dedicated spirit. Jocelyn, through her dedication and commitment to Jewish Youth was an inspiration to her family and many friends.

The lighting of this torch by the President of Maccabi Australia Inc. signals the opening of each carnival and, when the torch is extinguished at the conclusion, it is handed over to the Team Manager whose State will be hosts to the next carnival.

In this simple ceremony, therefore, Maccabi perpetuates the memory of a person who did so much for Jewish sport and ensures the perpetuation of its ideals.





Valda Litvinova is 14 years old. She is a swimmer of some note being the Israeli record holder in 100m breaststroke, 200m freestyle and 200m medley in her age group. But Valda represents more than just an outstanding swimmer. Valda was born in Zaporushy in the Ukraine. She was a member of the Russian

Swim Club Spartak - the only Jewish swimmer in the club until her family decided to make Aliyah.

In April 1990, during Passover, Valda and her family arrived in Israel. They settled in Tel Aviv where her father, who is a doctor, works at the Sharon Hospital in Petah Tikvah as does her mother, in the personnel department. Valda is in 9th grade. She swims for the Maccabi Tel Aviv Swimming Club and has already participated in 2 international competitions - one in Vienna last year and most recently the European Junior International Competition in August. Valda is just one of thousands of new immigrants that have flooded into Israel both prior to and especially since, the breakdown of the communist regime and the freeing up of emigration for Russian Jews. We, of the Diaspora, recognise the wonderful work being done in Israel to welcome and absorb those Olim.

NSW Maccabi have brought Valda to Sydney to participate in our 10th Junior Carnival so that we can have the opportunity of expressing our solidarity with the enormous task of absorption, as well as playing a small part in helping an Oleh gain a new identity within the global Jewish Community.

Welcome to Australia, Valda. We hope you enjoy your 1st Junior Carnival and that your presence here will give us a greater insight into the miracle of this newest Aliyah.

History of Australian Maccabi Junior Carnivals



The concept of a Junior Carnival was originated by the Executive of N.S.W. Maccabi in 1979 and was finally endorsed by the Australian Maccabi Federation in 1981 after much discussion as to the pros and cons of having a Carnival for the proposed age group of 11 years to 16 years. In fact, the event nearly didn't take place as the States were divided 2 all with South Australia not registering a vote. N.S.W. insisted that the A.M.F. force South Australia to take a vote one way or the other and, fortunately for all of us who today enjoy the spectacle of a Junior Carnival, S.A. voted that N.S.W. be allowed to conduct the first Junior Carnival

Perhaps the most significant thing about the first Junior Carnival apart from creating its own history, was that it was being conducted during the Golden Jubilee Year of Maccabi Carnivals and as one historic event was reaching a most significant milestone, so another was just starting. The success of the first Junior Carnival was perhaps best summed up by the then President of the A.M.F., Joe Bos, when he made note of the fact that in the first ever Junior Carnival, over 500 participants entered and that "like your predecessors in Carnival, in many cases your parents and grandparents, you will make many friends and these friendships you will value more than your medals. The bonds of sportsmanship will enhance the value of your life as young Australian Jews".

And so it is today on the eve of the 10th Australian Maccabi Junior Carnival. 10 days filled with sport, fun, excitement, and a choice of 21 different events. Those who win the ribbons will have a moment of glory. But those who participate will have a lifetime of friendship.


