





The Maccabiah For the 15th time in 65 years, the Maccabiah Games, scheduled for July 1997, will be held in Israel. Thousands of Jewish athletes, and tens of thousands of visitors from all over the world will converge in Israel, together embodying the central message of Maccabi: that Israel is at the heart of Jewish life. The 15th Maccabiah will usher in the celebrations of the 50th appiversary of the State, a year in

of the 50th anniversary of the State, a year in which all the Jewish people hope and pray that a real, secure peace will be achieved. Participation in this jubilee celebration is a unique opportunity to enjoy a festive celebration of the Israel experience.

The first Maccabiah was held in 1932, when 390 outstanding athletes from 17 countries gathered in what-was-then Palestine. Apart from the tragic interruption of World War II, the event has been held with ever increasing participation. The 15th Maccabiah, will be the largest yet. Some 6,000 athletes representing 50 countries will be competing in 43 different sports in selected locations throughout Israel.

The Maccabiah Games have come to represent the finest in Jewish sports. In these days of commercialization of sports, the Maccabiah has become one of the few major events in worldrecognized competitions, where friendly competition, a striving for excellence, and achievement remain the motivations. In addition to competitive events, there are cultural and social activities, excursions and numerous opportunities to experience the best Israel can offer.

Opening Ceremony, July 14, 1997

The I5th Maccabiah Opening Ceremony, presided over by the President of Israel, will take place on July 14, 1997 at 20:00 hours at the Ramat-Gan National Stadium.
